

The Hafesa Group makes new fuel deliveries to the Spanish Navy

• The Group has already delivered more than 25 million litres of naval diesel

Madrid, 27 December 2022.- The Hafesa Group has made an important delivery of fuel to the Spanish Navy this December for the arsenals at its bases under the Framework Agreement signed in March 2021.

The first delivery was made on 13 December 2021 and, since then, more than 25 million litres of naval diesel have been delivered in the ports of Ferrol and Cartagena. During the year, several shipments have been made, with the oil tankers unloading directly to the Navy arsenals. All the deliveries have been successfully completed, both in terms of the quality and the quantity of the merchandise.

The Managing Director of the Hafesa Group, Diego Guardamino, stresses the importance of being able to meet delivery terms and conditions despite the great supply difficulties caused by the pandemic and the economic and geopolitical situation. This has only possible due to firm alliances with large Spanish and international suppliers.

The business group, involved in the marketing and distribution of petroleum products, began operating in 2015 and, since then, has made a strong commitment to acquiring its own fuel storage plants in Spanish territory and offering its customers a more flexible service in all fields.

The Hafesa Group currently has four plants: two in the north, Bilbao and Gijón, one in the south, in Motril (Granada) and another in the centre of the Iberian Peninsula, Ocaña (Toledo), which will come into operation in the coming months. It has recently announced the acquisition of a fifth plant in the Outer Harbour at Ferrol (A Coruña). With all of them in operation, the company will have an accumulated overall storage capacity of more than 500,000 m³ for petrol, diesel and biofuels.
